"We are a family business that has been here in Bobcaygeon for close to 60 years", Greg commented, "learning about the situation at Pinecrest Nursing Home, we have felt very helpless during this time. We felt this was an opportunity to at least do something,"

The Bobcaygeon and Area COVID-19 Relief Fund is being managed by the Community Foundation of Kawartha Lakes. "This donation by British Empire Fuels is a heartwarming show of community support," noted foundation President Mike Perry.
